The latest example is tax relief, where the difference between the final vetoed tax bill and the tax bill that was passed during the special session on June 18th was so minuscule that the Governor had no logical reason to veto it in the first place, and in my opinion, wasted taxpayer money by calling a special session.

What are your 3 top priorities?

1. Continuing the fight for lower taxes.
2. Defending rural Kansas family values and constitutional rights.
3. Keeping our communities safe by supporting legislation that holds criminals accountable for their actions.

What do you think sets you apart from the other candidates? Although I'm running unopposed this year, I believe my experience as an active law enforcement officer gives me a unique perspective on law enforcement issues facing Kansans.
